

The one line-graph shows the comparison between the percentage of families who have three kinds of electrical appliances. While another graph provides how much time each household uses per week for 99 years for one country from 1920 to 2019.

It can be seen that the number of families who have all three electrical appliances, washing machines, refrigerators, and vacuum-cleaner, increased from 1920 to 2019. Moreover, using electronic appliances reduced constantly during 99 years.

Refrigerators, in the year 1920, had the least users. In contrast, the washing machine was popular in that year with nearly 40 percent of households. However, refrigerator users considerably increased until 2019; Therefore, every family had that in their house from 1980 to 2019. Similar to the refrigerators, vacuum cleaners, was in all houses from 2000 to 2019.

From 1960 to 1980 the washing machine had a slight decrease in use. But, in 2019, the washing machine users had negligible raise and reached approximately 75 percent of the user. In 1920, people used their electrical appliances so much, 50 hours per week. However, it remarkably decreased to 10 hours per week after 99 years.
