

The line charts demonstrate the proportion of electrical appliances such as washing machine, refrigerator and vacuum cleaner that owned to people and also illustrate the number of used hours during 100 years.

Overall, household achieve more and more electrical facilities throughout the years, while the number of time when they spent doing works decreased significantly.

In 1920, most people did not have a refrigerator and the percentage was near zero. But 30% and 40% of them owned vacuum cleaners and washing machines respectively. In the next 20 years, saw a considerable increase in ownerships of refrigerator around 55% which was between other appliances. In 1960, while households of a vacuum cleaner and washing machine were 70%, the owner of a refrigerator took over the others with 90%. The hours of consumption dropped impressively from 50 to 20 between the years 1920 and 1960.

In the year 1980, there was a fall between the people who had washing machine by 5% to 65% and equipment of cleaner had risen to 90%. In 2000 and 2019, even though, the households with refrigerator and vacuum cleaner had the highest proportion with 100%, And the Proprietor of the washing machine had a slight increase from 70% to around 75%, but the amount of spent hours Reduced A steadily from 15 to 10 hours per week.
